CONDITIONS RELATING TO EXTRA TUITION

Extra Tuition is only provided with the express written permission of a parent. Every effort will be made to make up lessons missed for any reason, but when a lesson is missed through no fault of the teacher concerned we cannot guarantee that it will be made up and under these circumstances the normal charge will be made. The annual fees normally cover 30 lessons per academic year, divided between the three terms. Where this proves impossible, the number of lessons per term will be adjusted to ensure a total of 30 in the full year. For administrative purposes, the cost is divided equally between the three terms.

Please write to the relevant Head of Department if you wish your daughter either to commence, discontinue or alter existing arrangements regarding extra subjects. This information is required to ensure that the pupils' records and fees to be charged are correct.

A term's notice in writing is required to discontinue any extra subject/activity
A term's fees will be charged if correct notice is not given.

Payment is in arrears and will be added to the following term's account and is payable no later than the 28th of the first month of the following term.

SUNDRY EXTRAS

Excursions and other sundry extras can be requested by a pupil and can sometimes be a necessary part of the curriculum, for which a charge might be made. Practical subjects such as Food Technology will also incur charges for goods used.

In the case of field trips, PE tours and overseas visits, the College will request permission from the parent and full payment in advance.

EXAMINATION FEES
